The XIIth Colloquium of AIEMA will take place in Venice, from the 11 to 15 of September, 2012, at the invitation of Prof. Carlo Carraro, Rector of Ca' Foscari University, and upon the initiative of Prof. Giordana Trovabene.

## Themes

The colloquium's **main theme** deals with wall mosaics from their origins to the Middle Ages. Besides grottoes and nymphaea, attention is focused on basins in domestic contexts, basins in baths (public and private), ceilings and vaults in residential, monumental, cultic, and funerary contexts, etc.

A **second theme** consists of new discoveries and unpublished works, comprising all types of mosaics (on walls as well as pavements).

## Presentations

These may take the form of 15-minute talks or posters reviewed by the Scientific Committee, which can direct participants toward either type of presentation. Both types will be published in the Colloquium Acts.
